1st Understand

Backstory. Q: How did the geography, resources, and historical characters influence this Q: _____ wrote this text. What was his past relationship with the original audience? Q: What circumstance caused this story to be written to the original audience? Q: What is the genre of the text? Words Matter. Q: In context, which words or phrases did the writer emphasize to make key points to the original audience? Q: Who are the main characters in this story, and were they role models or object Q: What are the tensions, conflicts, and actions that drove this story? Q: Where does this story fit into the biblical meta-story? What did God say? Q: What did God reveal about Himself in this story? Q: What issue (sin) did God expose to the original audience? Q: What (Truth, Insight, or Principle) did God teach in this story? Q: What action did God prescribe for the original audience?
